- **Scottish National Investment Bank** – long-term patient capital, and shaped by a mission-orientated approach.

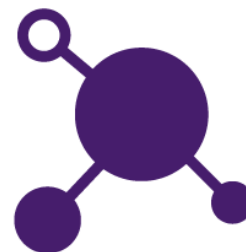
